- In our school family, elementary students are able to connect with middle school and high school students through chapel, prayer buddies, one-on-one mentoring, and special events. This is something unique to Shiloh because of our all-inclusive campus. We find that it benefits both the elementary students by giving them a sense of importance and confidence with the older role model students and also our older students gain important leadership skills.
- Bible class, weekly chapels, Scripture memory, and prayer time in each grade help our students build a solid foundation in their faith.
- We are the only school in the city with a cohesive K-12 visual arts program.
- We are able to provide small class sizes at all of our grade levels. This helps to enable close relationships between not only the student and the teacher, but also the parent and the teacher. You will know each other.
- Students have the opportunity to participate in camps throughout the summer for our younger students, and often are coached by our student athletes and musicians.
