

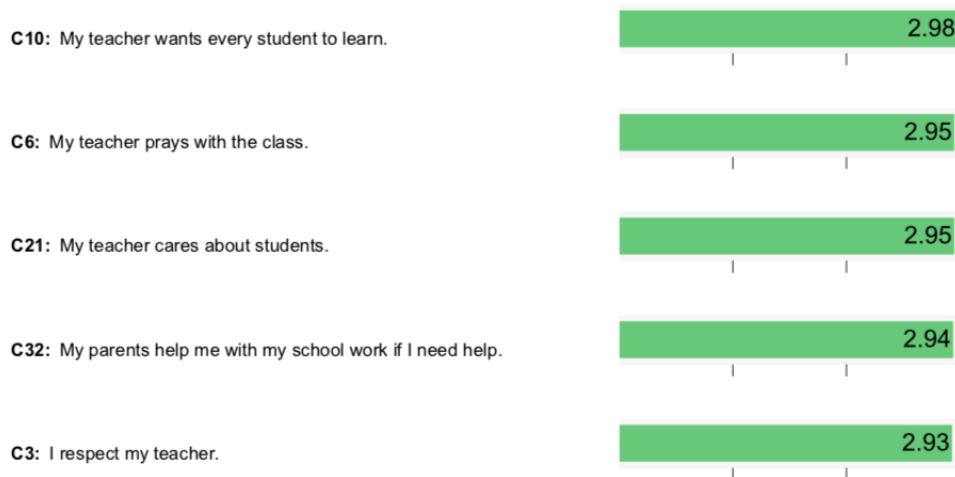
Shiloh Fall 2018 Survey Report



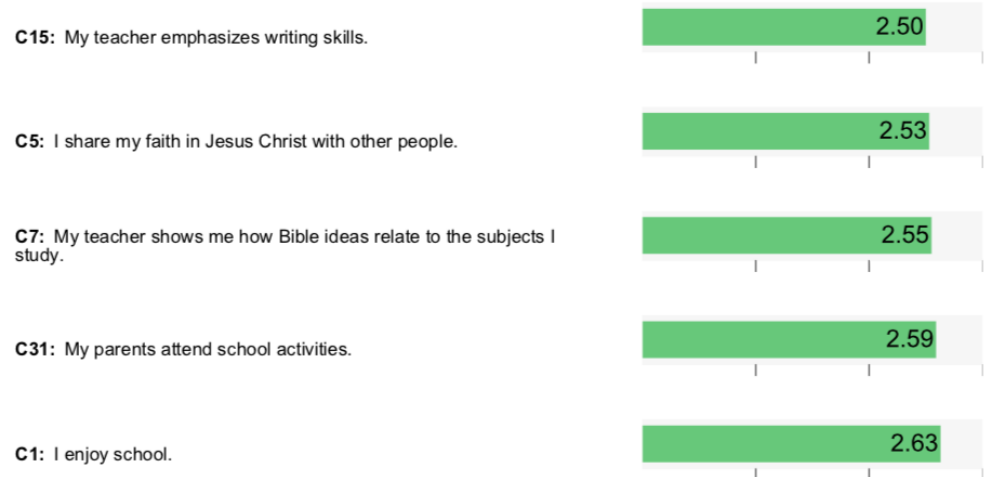
Elementary Students Grades 3 – 6 Results

Highest Scoring Items



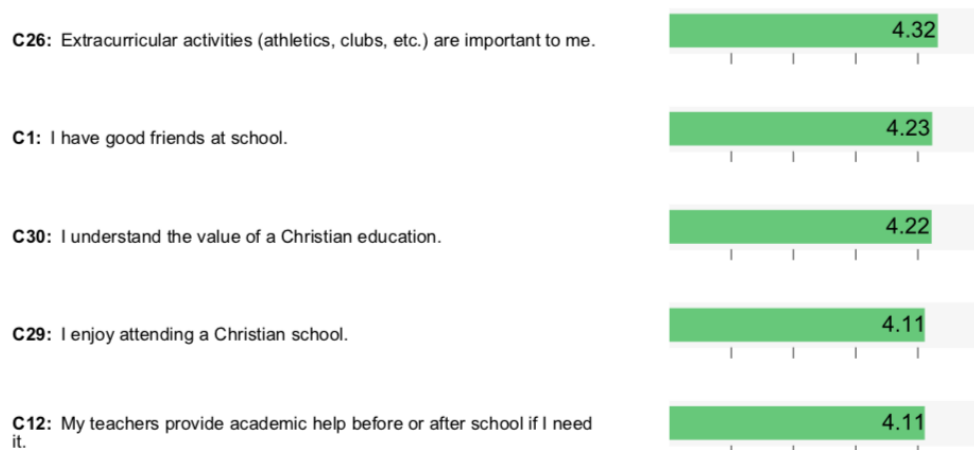
Lowest Scoring Items

C15: The spiritual mission of the school (why it exists) is clearly stated.

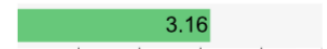


C30: The school is a safe place for my child.

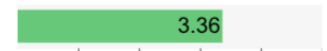


Lowest Scoring Items

C55: I am open to change that will improve our school.

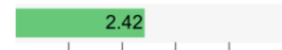

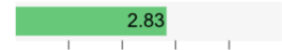
C49: Transfer students entering my class are prepared academically.



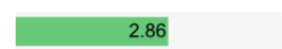
C19: Standardized test results help me in my teaching.
