
Shiloh Fall 2018 Survey Report




Elementary Students Grades 3 – 6 Results

Shiloh had 133 responses to the "Elementary Christian Identity" survey. The overall average score was 2.79 out of a three-point scale.



MS/HS Students Grades 7 – 12 Results

Shiloh had 185 responses to the "MS/HS Christian Identity" survey. The overall average score was 3.69 out of a five-point scale.



Parent Survey Results

Shiloh had 86 responses to the "Parent Christian Identity" survey. The **overall average score** was **4.05** out of a five-point scale.
